When the risen Jesus encounters his disciples on the road to Emmaus, it's quite clear that their journeying away from Jerusalem is in fact a journeying away from hope. Jesus, of course, turns them around—quite literally. The encounter with the risen Christ means a renewed encounter with hope; that God is not done yet; that darkness and suffering do not have the final word. This encounter with resurrection is what our Lenten journey points to. And this story of Emmaus is a helpful one in reflecting on what it means to build a culture of encounter, to become missionary disciples.
