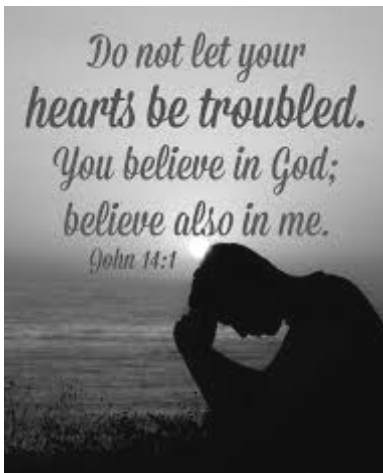

So how do we regroup when our faith is tested? The best thing you can do is go easy on yourself. Were the apostles' hearts troubled after Jesus ascended into heaven? Yes, often. Did they lose their peace? Yes, often. Didn't they have the Holy Spirit in them? Yes. So why couldn't they hold firm? Because even the great apostles Peter,

James, and John were still only human. Sometimes it takes time, even years, to develop that level of faith and trust. Remember how Peter lost his trust and denied even knowing the Lord? He wept bitterly when he realized what he had done, but he didn't remain trapped in that bitterness and guilt. When he saw Jesus on the Sea of Galilee, he jumped into the water and ran to him. He let Jesus reassure him, and he resolved to keep moving forward in faith. So whenever your faith is tested, or whatever you are struggling with right now, remember that Jesus knows you. He knows your worries. He is with you, surrounding you with his love. Try your best to rest in him. **"Lord, help me to keep moving forward, to hold my peace, and to trust in you."**
