Know the Movement of your Heart ~ Discerning the Holy Spirit requires our being aware of the movement of our heart/soul. Are our thoughts, words and actions moving us toward God or away from God? What we think, say and do give us a good indicator of what kind of spirit is moving our heart/soul. Receive and remain within God's love, His peace, the hope of God's omnipotence and the faith in His omniscience. Receive and remain in the presence of God. Experience and know the heart-felt intimacy of being loved by God and in loving our neighbor with the same kind of love. Experience your heart and mind being touched by mercy and unconditional love as you extend this same kin of love to your neighbors. Experience and know the impact of uplifting and kind words and of being a voice of **hope** and encouragement. Experience and know God moving you to tears and be thankful for these mysterious, healing and liberating moments of intimacy with God. Experience and know an ever increasing Faith, Hope and Love. Seek the Spirit of consolation, care, peace, and God's personal presence. When your heart/soul has desolation, unhappiness, misery, sadness, moodiness, gloom, no enthusiasm, confusion, discouragement, absence of God, be aware of these movements of the heart. They are from the enemy! Reject them! Redirect them by increasing prayer, meditating on God's promises which are the foundation of our faith, hope and love; by examining our habits of thoughts, words and actions allowing God to chastise us and change our movement of heart and by doing acts of greater penance during these times of desolation. By doing these actions, we are moving our heart into proper discernment of the Holy Spirit.
