Today's parable of the ten virgins urges us to be alert and awake, ready for the time when Jesus will come again. Jesus wants to make it clear that a time will come when each person is either welcomed into heaven or finds the door barred before them. He wants to warn us so that no one gets left out.

It seems that it's the oil that determines whether we are ready to meet Jesus. We could call it faith, the Holy Spirit, the grace of God, or our relationship with him. Whatever it is, it's something that we can't borrow from a friend. We have to be prepared with our own supply.

Jesus wants us to keep our faith alive every single day. We have a prime opportunity to check our faith when we proclaim the Creed every Sunday at Mass. Actually, we can do this every day in our personal prayer. So let's proclaim our faith today. Let's fill up our oil flasks by announcing our belief in Jesus, our Savior.
