While some of us are keen to begin Lent, some may feel disheartened at the prospect of keeping their Lenten resolutions. If this is you, don't worry. Paul's words have come at just the right time. Keep your focus on your love for Jesus. Running errands. Doing laundry. Caring for a spouse. Even fasting. These can all become opportunities to let your love for God work itself outward into every nook and cranny of your life. This is the heart of Lent: putting aside temporary pleasures in order to become satisfied in God.

### **Fasting & Abstinence Rules:**

Abstinence (abstaining from meat) and Fasting (One meal and, if necessary, two smaller meals to maintain sufficient strength) are to be observed on Ash Wed. & Good Friday.

All Fridays during Lent require abstinence. All persons who are 14 and older should honor the law of fast and abstinence up to the age of 60.
